



Confederation of Mediterranean Badminton (COMEBA)



COMEBA – Organisation of the “Mediterranean Cup” and Training Camp 2017.

It is COMEBA’s intention to organise another edition of the two captioned events during 2017.

The following are therefore the relevant organisational details about them and their organisation:

- The overall event should preferably start with the “Mediterranean Cup” and then be followed by the Training Camp. Alternatively, it can start with the latter and then be followed by the former; and this at the Organiser’s discretion.
- The exact location and dates are to be notified by the Organiser from the outset.
- It would be preferable if both events take place consecutively during the summer months.
- The said Training Camp and the “Mediterranean Cup” tournament are specifically intended for players born in 2000 or later.
- The "Mediterranean Cup" will consist of both an Individual as well as a Team tournament.
- The Individual competition will comprise all five categories (Singles and Doubles); during its first round, it will be played in Groups and not on a Knock-Out basis.
- Each fixture in the Team competition will consist of five games: MS-WS-MD-WD-MXD; the competition will similarly be played in Groups during its initial stage.
- The Organiser is to provide prizes to the winners.
- The Organiser is to offer free accommodation (on full board basis) to four players (two males and two females) as well as to one coach representing each COMEBA member Association / Federation; and this for the duration of both events.

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- The participants are to arrive on the day before the start and are to depart on the day after the finish of the overall event.
- The Organiser is also to look after all internal transport arrangements, including airport transfers; these must be provided free of charge to all the participants.
- The hire of the sports hall as well as the shuttlecocks used are the responsibility of the Organiser.
- The identity of the coach appointed to conduct the Training Camp must be notified by the Organiser as early as reasonably possible before the start of the event.
- The Organiser is to promote both events on its website and/or Facebook. It is also to promote the coverage of both events with local television and radio stations; the former can be invited to film parts of the two events for broadcast purposes.
- The Organiser is to invite prominent national personalities to the prize-giving ceremony at the end of the "Mediterranean Cup" team and individual competitions.
- The Organiser is to provide all the necessary assistance to the participants who may require a visa to enter the country.
- COMEBA will endeavour to secure funding from the BWF to support the overall organisational cost incurred by the Organiser; and this both in respect of the "Mediterranean Cup" as well as of the Training Camp. In this regard, the Organiser will be required to submit in advance an itemised estimate of the overall projected cost.
